 - i. a copy of the office action(s) just prior to the “Decision to Grant a Patent” from each of the Global/IP5 PPH participating office application(s) containing the allowable/patentable claim(s),
 - ii. if the allowable/patentable claim(s) are from a “Notification of Reasons for Refusal” then the Notification of Reasons for Refusal,
 - iii. if the Global/IP5 PPH participating office application is a first action allowance then no office action from the Global/IP5 PPH participating office is necessary should be indicated on the request/petition form or
